The Boston Cleaning Collective (BCC) has received two grants from the Catholic Campaign for Human Development, beginning in 2019. The total amount granted by the CCHD over those two years is \$150,000, including the \$75,000 grant it received for the [2020-2021 grants cycle](#).

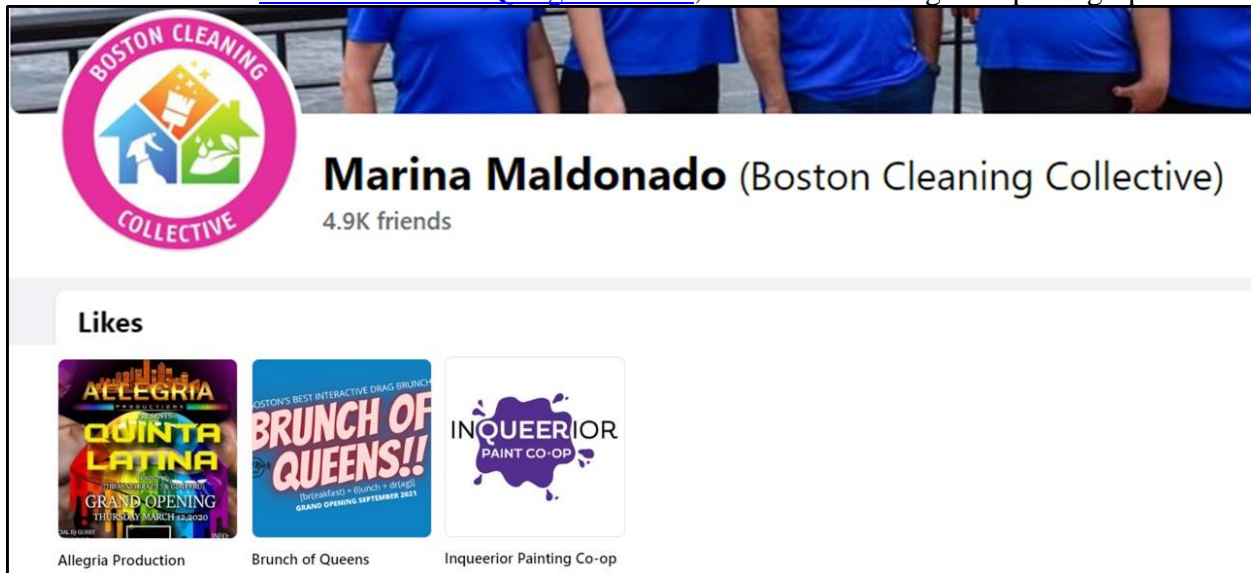
