The vice president of United Latinos is Josie Morales, and her bio on the United Latinos website identifies her as "Capitana of the National Brown Berets Sacramento Unit."

Josie Morales Vice President



Born and raised in Sacramento, California, Ms. Morales is a retired Paralegal with a 20+ yr career in the legal industry specializing in civil litigation. Ms. Morales comes from working class roots which inspired her to join the labor movement as a Team Leader and Job Steward with SEIU Local 1000. Her volunteer work includes working with NorCal Resist assisting asylum seekers and undocumented families; outreach to the houseless community with Feed Sacramento Homeless; committee member with Sacramento Investment without Displacement; Godmother with The Godmothers of Nor-Cal Las Madrinas, helping families with children 0-5 years old who are experiencing homelessness or facing financial hardship. Ms. Morales is the Capitana of the National Brown Berets Sacramento Unit and an original member of the first all Mujeres National Brown Berets Oakland Unit.

The <u>Brown Berets are a Marxist paramilitary organization</u> founded in 1967 and modeled after the Black Panthers.

In addition to being an officer in a Marxist paramilitary outfit, Morales actively promotes abortion and LGBTQ ideologies.

In a gross display of inhumanity, Morales celebrated the death of Queen Elizabeth on <u>September</u> 8, 2022.



On <u>July 19, 2022</u>, Morales called for people to help her boost enrollment to a class she was taking on LGBTQ studies. She indicated that the class would focus on "LGBTQ/queer experience in American society" by examining terminology and theory, "U.S. LGBTQ/queer history," and " art, politics, and culture of LGBTQ communities."

It's the only Intro to LGBTQ Studies course offered at ARC, and only one of two such courses offered in the Los Rios district. I want to make sure it sticks, so I would very much appreciate some helping spreading the word! Thank you!

This semester, Professor Sara Smith is teaching Social Justice 310: Introduction to LGBTQ Studies as a hybrid course. The class meets once per week in-person, from 1:30-2:50 pm. on the ARC campus. The section number is 19261.

What is the class about?


It's an interdisciplinary course focused on the LGBTQ/queer experience in American society. It's divided into three units. The first short unit focuses on terminology and theory. The second unit consists of several weeks and is focused on U.S. LGBTQ/queer history. For the third unit of the class, which also lasts several weeks, we focus on art, politics, and culture of LGBTQ communities. For instance, one entire week is focused on queer music, another on queer immigration, and another is focused on queer and trans representation in TV and movies.

The class approaches the subject through an intersectional lens, making sure to highlight race, class, and disability as they intersect with gender and sexuality in the experiences of queer and trans people in the U.S.

The main assignments are: 1) discussion forums every 2 of 3 weeks; 2) an oral history assignment in which you listen to or watch short interviews with people involved in gueer history in some way; 3) and a gueer literary assignment that involves you reading a memoir or novel of your choice and writing a short 3-4 page book review essay about it. There are no big exams and no small quizzes. And all of the required reading is provided free of charge!

If you know anybody who might be interested in taking the class, please spread the word! The course was first offered in the Spring of 2020, and it's the *first-ever* course in LGBTQ studies offered at ARC. "


